JOB DESCRIPTION

The Site Supervisor manages an assigned team consisting of a foreman and installation crew members, through the daily activities at the installation job site. This person is responsible for the safety of all GSS employees onsite, safe working conditions are adhered to and efficient completion of projects.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensures a safe work environment, safety equipment and practices at the job site.
- Manages all onsite responsibilities and project time lines, escalating concerns to Assistant Project Manager when appropriate.
- Communicates professionally and timely with the Assistant Project Manager and customers.
- Reports job site tools and equipment concerns including rental and GSS owned items to the Assistant Project Manager.
- Collaborates with foreman and installation crew members to ensure quality control of job site cleanliness, appropriate behaviors and proper use of rental equipment.
- Relays any potential GSS product improvements to Assistant Project Manager.
- Assembles and installs all GSS and third party product installations.
- Follows building and safety standards and codes when installing SPECTO products.
- Verifies electrical installation and wiring meet GSS specifications, troubleshooting problems and concerns.
- Verifies proper calibration of GSS products and reports any concerns to Assistant Project Manager.
- Provides high quality photos and video footage as requested by Project Manager (pre-install, install, post-install, safety related, drone footage, etc.)
- Trains customers on proper use and maintenance of GSS supplied products.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
